# How to get to the Bernoulli Center, EPFL

The Bernoulli Center is located on the EPFL campus, map.

Address: Chemin des Alambics, Bâtiment GA, Station 5, 1015 Lausanne. Telephone: +41 21 693 64 30 The entrance is on the north side of the building, and you will find us on the third floor.



Whether you land in Geneva airport (GVA) or Zurich Airport (ZRH), the train stations are located in the airports and direct trains travel regularly.

Geneva airport is the nearest airport from Lausanne, around 50 minutes by train. To reach the Bernoulli Center from Geneva airport, you have three options: direct train to Lausanne, to Renens or to Morges.

Zurich airport is a 2.5-hour train ride to Lausanne. Make sure you select a direct train.

To reach the Bernoulli Center from these different train stations, please follow the instructions below:

## From Lausanne train station

• Take the metro line M2 from *Lausanne Gare Station* in the direction *Croisettes*, get off at the next stop *Lausanne-Flon* and change to metro line M1. Travel on metro line M1 in the direction *Renens Gare*, get off at *Unil-Sorge* and walk 5 minutes to the Bernoulli Center (see map below).

From Renens station

• Take the metro line M1 in the direction *Lausanne-Flon*, get off at *Unil-Sorge* and walk 5 minutes to the Bernoulli Center (see map below).





# From Morges station

• Take the bus no 701 from *Morges gare* in the direction *Lausanne Bourdonnette*, get off at *Ecublens VD*, *Champagne* bus stop and walk 5 minutes to the Bernoulli Center.





# From the studio apartments in Lausanne

(VisionApartments, rue Caroline 23, 1003 Lausanne)

• Take the metro line M2 from *Bessières* in the direction of *Ouchy*, get off at *Lausanne-Flon* and change to metro line M1. Travel on metro line M1 in the direction *Renens Gare*, get off at *Unil-Sorge* and walk 5 minutes to the Bernoulli Center (see map above).

## From SwissTech and Starling Hotels on the EPFL campus

Both hotels are located just about 10 minutes' walk to the Bernoulli Center (see maps below).





## From Victoria Hotel in Lausanne

• Take the metro line M2 from *Lausanne Gare Station* in the direction *Croisettes*, get off at the next stop *Lausanne-Flon* and change to metro line M1. Travel on metro line M1 in the direction *Renens Gare*, get off at *Unil-Sorge* and walk 5 minutes to the Bernoulli Center (see map on page 1).



## Access by car

From the highway, follow the direction *Lausanne-Sud* and take the exit *EPFL-Ecublens*. For visitor parking spaces, please refer to the <u>website</u>. Further detailed information on how to get to EPFL is also available on the EPFL website (<u>Coming to EPFL</u>).

Fairtiq is a good app if you are staying for a longer period (i.e. not in a hotel).

Your hotel will provide you with a <u>transport card</u> allowing free public transport within the greater Lausanne area (trains, buses, and metros) for the duration of your stay (max 15 days). This also covers Renens but does not cover Morges. Please note that stays in apartments are not eligible for this offer.

Please note that you can also use local public transportation for free on your day of arrival (e.g. from Renens or Lausanne station to EPFL or your hotel), you would need to show your hotel reservation confirmation, should there be a ticket controller.

For long-term visitors and if you intend to travel intensively in Lausanne or Switzerland, you may purchase a "half fare card" or Lausanne passes or Swiss passes. Use apps such as Fairtig and Swiss mobile app to reduce hassles.

## Shops

Shops in Lausanne are usually open from 8am to 7pm from Mondays to Fridays, until 6pm on Saturdays. Shops are closed on Sundays and during public holidays.

- There are large supermarkets (Coop and Migros) south of the main Lausanne train station.
- The Coop Supermarket Lausanne Caroline (rue Caroline 6) is a good place to find services and various shops for everyday use, groceries, electronics, repairs, etc.
- The small Coop at the Lausanne train station is open on Sundays and late evenings.
- Coop, Migros, and Manor sell prepared meals. It's easy to find good cheese, dry meats, and good bread. Most hotels and apartments provide also microwaves and hot water kettles either in the room or in a common area.

A real Lausanne institution, the town centre market sets out its stalls every Wednesday and Saturday mornings from *Place de la Palud* and *Place St-François*.

## Activities
